The event was initiated by the **University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine of Bucharest** in 2012, and will be held in Bucharest, Romania, between **04th and 06th of June 2026**. 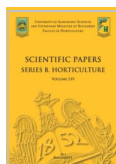

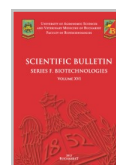

Participation at the conference is **mandatory** in order for the paper to be evaluated, **but does not guarantee publication acceptance**. **Only papers** accepted in the peer review process pertaining to registered authors that participated at the conference can be included in **the scientific journals**. Should a paper be submitted by a **team of authors** and co-authors, **attendance is mandatory** for a minimum of **one** representative of aforementioned team. Submission of the paper implies that it is an original article and it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere.
